The Best Start Grant School Age Payment is £250 to help



with the costs of starting school. If you have a child aged between 2 and 3 ½, you may also qualify for the Best Start Grant Early Learning Payment.

If you are at least 24 weeks pregnant or within 6 months of giving birth, you may also qualify for a Best Start Grant Pregnancy and Baby Payment.
